- 1. Command (1a): walk before me

- C. Circumcision: The Sign of God's Covenant [9-14]
 - 1. Circumcision is a cutting off a part of that member of the body through which God's promise will be fulfilled.
 - 2. The point of this graphic and permanent sign is that we can never achieve God blessings, even the blessings guaranteed by His promises (covenant), *by our own power*.

- 3. As Genesis 1 and 2 taught us that the maleness and femaleness and the union of a man and a woman as husband and wife is at its core, spiritual. It is not primarily about: biology, or psychology, or sociology, but theology
- 4. Circumcision affirms that sexuality is about our relationship with God!
 - a. Fertility (blessing) is a gift from El Shaddai, a consequence of His unmerited favor (grace) and a means by which we receive even more of His blessings. It is not merely a biological outcome or result of human action.
