## Getting The Words Right, part 2 PRAISE Psalm 146

Introduction

## A. Life Is About Praise [1-2]

1. There is no word for "to thank" in Hebrew, although the concept certainly exists. Praise is not merely formal thanksgiving

THANKS	PRAISE
The one being thanked remains in place	The one being praised is elevated
I am the subject; I am expressing my thanks.	God is the subject; I am directed away from myself.
Thanks can be a required action, a duty	Praise is by its nature free, joyful, often spontaneous
Thanks needs only two people present: the one thanking and the one being thanked. It is thus basically private.	Praise needs an audience, it thus usually occurs in a group.
Thanks occurs in the speaking of "Thank you" or "Thanks."	Praise requires a sentence and can occur even if the word "praise" is not used.

2. "I will praise the Lord" means "I will tell others what the Lord has done for me."

B. Warning: Trust in people and you will be disappointed [3-4]

C. Exhortation: Trust in God and you will be blessed [5-6]

D. Explanation: The Lord helps the helpless and the hopeless [7-9]
